 On July 1, 2011, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc. (Montana-Dakota or MDU) and Mountrail-Williams Electric Cooperative (Mountrail-Williams) filed a joint application for approval of a Service Area Agreement to establish service areas and designate service locations to be served by Montana-Dakota and Mountrail-Williams within the City of Williston, North Dakota, and surrounding areas.
