Contract 7-9C will be received by the North Dakota State Water Commission (NDSWC), Bismarck, ND until 1:30 P.M., Local Time on the 4th day of August, 2011 where and at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. The WORK under CONTRACT 7-9C includes furnishing and installing approximately 143 miles of 6" - 1 1/2" ASTM D2241 gasketed joint pipe; 304 services; road crossings; railroad crossings; connections to existing pipelines and other related appurtenances. On July 1, 2011, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc. (Montana-Dakota or MDU) and Mountrail-Williams Electric Cooperative (Mountrail-Williams) filed a joint application for approval of a Service Area Agreement to establish service areas and designate service locations to be served by Montana-Dakota and Mountrail-Williams within the City of Williston, North Dakota, and surrounding areas. Montana-Dakota further request that Montana-Dakota be issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to extend service to locations within the Montana-Dakota service area set forth in the agreement.
The issues to be considered in this proceeding are whether the Service Area Agreement complies with section 49-03-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, and whether the approval of the Service Area Agreement and resulting certificate issuance are compatible with the public interest.

An informal hearing of this matter is scheduled to begin on August 24, 2011, at 1:30 p.m. CT in the Commission Hearing Room on the 12th floor of the State Capitol. At the informal hearing, the Commission will discuss this matter with the parties and interested members of the public.
