
Submitted with the application was a statement by Mark Ames that the customer desires electric service to be provided by the applicant. Service is to be provided at a point located in:

**The SE ¼, SW ¼, of Section 17, Twp 140N, R 61W, Barnes County, North Dakota.**


Otter Tail Power Company has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.


