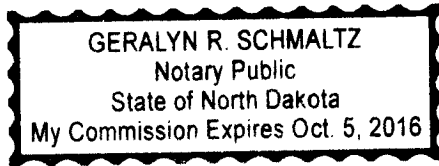

The SE ¼, SW ¼, of Section 17, Twp 140N, R 61W, Barnes County, North Dakota.


Otter Tail Power Company has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.


