

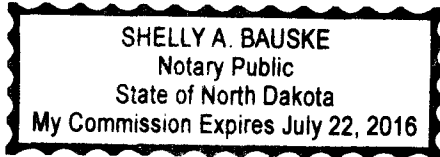


**Order**
