

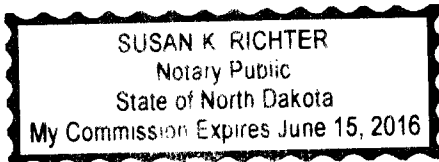


Order
