Enclosed is your North Dakota Grain Warehouse License and relevant documents for the elevator at Courtenay, North Dakota. Your license and each of the colored posters must be displayed at the facility in an area easily visible by patrons.

State law requires that licensees submit monthly reports within 30 days of the end of each month. Courtenay has been assigned grain movement number **1215**. This number must be used on all monthly report forms which are available on the Commission's website at <http://psc.nd.gov/forms/grain/grain-movement-and-storage-report.pdf> or the forms can be filed electronically at <http://www.ugpti.org/grain/>.

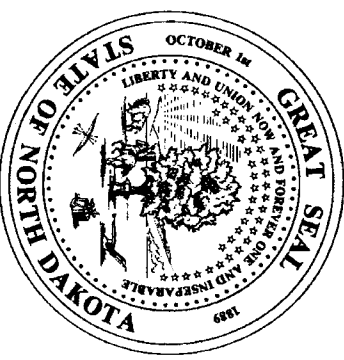

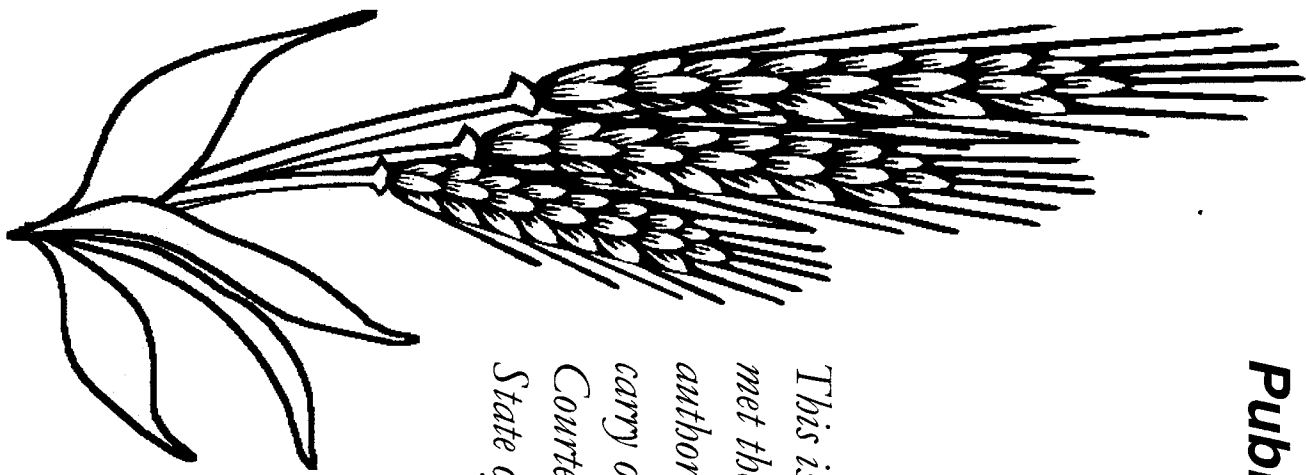
