

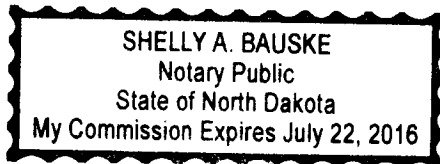

Order


The Commission orders:

2. Business as a roving grain buyer in North Dakota is discontinued and Technology Crops, Inc. shall not conduct any further business under license number 3094.


