On October 31, 2011, Oliver Wind III, LLC filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility to authorize construction of the 48 MW Wind Energy Center consisting of up to 30 wind turbine generators and associated facilities in Morton County, North Dakota as shown on the attached map. A Public Hearing on the application is scheduled to begin on December 20, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. CST at the Mandan City Hall, 205 Second Ave NW, Mandan, ND 58554. The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the

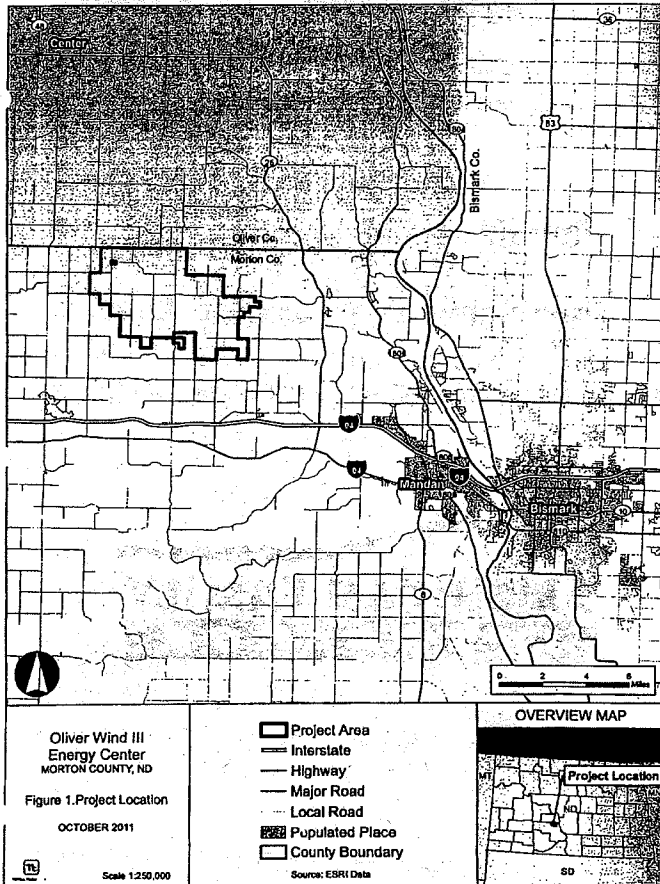
environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
