Sewer Improvement (Schmidt South) construction agreement with Kuechle Under-ground Inc. Motion carried. In accordance to the agreement work will be completed and ready for final payment as follows: Schedules A and D - November 1, 2011 and Schedules B and C - June 2012.

DSI WATERSALESMAN Preliminary drawings are in progress for the outside Watersalesman and will be reviewed with Engineer Ike. Materials have been ordered for the two buildings, pumps and tanks will also be ordered with water sales to begin in November. One common style pump is recommended so all spare parts are the same. DSI would like to lease some property near the water site looping off of 61st St NW for a building. Drawings and plans will be brought to the next council meeting.

ALLIED ENGINEER UPDATE Allied Engineer Travis Frey was present to request signatures for projects in the John Rian Addition. A motion was made by Enget second by Nohr to approve Mayor, Attorney and Auditor to sign documents for John Rian Addition District #45 Water and Sewer Improvement and District #46 Street Improvement. Motion carried.

POLICE REPORT Chief Halvorson reported that with the recent legislation, codes need to be adopted. A motion was made by Weisenberger second by Nohr to adopt Century Code 12.1, 39, 19, and 62.1 of the North Dakota Century Code dealing with criminal codes. Motion carried. A motion was made by Lindahl and second by Nohr to sign and accept the \$3,000 grant for the seat belt enforcement when the contract is received. Motion carried.

CITY COORDINATOR REPORT Coordinator Heidbreder reported that Jon Corpron had approached him if the city is interested in doing maintenance on the portion of the new sewer line that will be serving his development from the pond road north. Heidbreder recommends we do not maintain that portion of the sewer system north of the pond road since it is not built to the specifications of the North Dakota Health Department, in which we would be in violation because a manhole was omitted.

Heidbreder was contacted by the Dakota West Credit Union that is currently under reconstruction with a request to remove the street light on the south west corner adjacent to their property land put in their lighted message sign with their logo. They guarantee that it will put out the same amount of light as the existing street light, if not they will add additional lighting to the top of the sign. Consensus of council would permit as long as there is adequate lighting in the area.

Heidbreder attended the RT meeting and stated the water plant is progressing and is on schedule to be productive in March 2012. There will be a planned water outage but have not set the date for that yet so we will have to conserve water during that period. The joint powers agreement is currently in the hands of Williams County Water Resource Board for their review at which time Stanley will become a member of the RT Water Association. RT has two vacant seats on the western water supply board and there is also a requirement for an alternate to be from the Stanley Service area. The alternate does not have to be a council member but can be any water consumer.

Heidbreder said the sweeper is getting old and needs to be replaced. He received a price quote of \$151,000 and would like council to consider this purchase. This would have to be bid since it is over \$100,000. We are also in need of a garbage truck before the one we have breaks down. Probably cost of a truck would be between \$162,000 to \$172,000 range. Weisenberger wants to pursue contracting the garbage out either through Circle Sanitation or Waste Management.

A motion was made by Lindahl second by Weisenberger to approve the Coordinators Report. Motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS Drivers License had sent a letter asking to be located in the City Hall again. The library building was too small for what they needed. Consensus of council suggests they try to locate elsewhere since there is limited space in the council room.

A complaint was received from Haynes concerning their recent special assessment at 419 1st St SW. Attorney Enget will address the issue. All the publications were put in the newspaper according to statute.

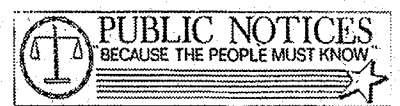
Council concerns included discussion of multiple renters in houses that have not been permitted, abandoned vehicles, road access to the Annabelle Home Addition.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.0504 OF THE STANLEY CITY ORDINANCES RELATING TO DEFINITION OF SINGLE FAMILY DWELLINGS IN RELATION TO ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF STANLEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANLEY, MOUNTRAIL COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA THAT 5.0504 (2) BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

5.0504 Re-Residential District

1. Purpose: To establish and preserve general residential neighborhoods which allow for varied types of residential development.

2. Permitted Uses: Single family dwellings, parks, churches, public and parochial schools, hospitals, clinics and customary accessory uses associated with the permitted uses. Single family dwellings shall be defined as follows:

A. One or more persons related by blood, marriage, adoption, or legal guardianship, including foster children, living in a dwelling; or

B. A group of not more than three (3) persons not related by blood, marriage, adoption, or legal guardianship living together in a dwelling; or

C. Two (2) unrelated persons and their children living together in a dwelling.
