On February 25, 2009, in Case No. PU-08-844, the Commission issued Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 109 and Route Permit No. 119 to Whiting Oil and Gas Corporation authorizing construction and operation of 17 miles of eight-inch crude oil pipeline with associated facilities and pipeline interconnections in Mountrail County, North Dakota.

On August 30, 2011, Whiting Oil and Gas Corporation (Whiting) and Plains Pipeline, L.P. (Plains) submitted a joint application for the transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 109 and Route Permit No. 119 to Plains, Case No. PU-11-567.

The issues to be considered in Case No. PU-11-567 are whether Plains Pipeline, L.P. agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of the certificate issued to Whiting Oil and Gas Corporation, and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by November 21, 2011. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
