Dear Travis, Londa, and Pat:

As a follow-up to yesterday's matter concerning : **T130N R95W Section 22, SE1/4, Duck Creek Township, Adams County, and Thunder Spirit Wind Farm**, the State Historical Society of North Dakota has assigned 32ADX204 to the small rectangular untilled parcel in the SE1/4 as marked on and described in the NDCRS site form attachment. Any updated historical or other information regarding the location is most appreciated.

Attached are a copy of the (1) 32ADX204 NDCRS site form and (2) the earliest Duck Creek Township plat map that lists an Andreas Wahlquist for the 160-acre parcel in S1/2 of SE1/4 for Section 22. Current Adam County plats list the Zimmerman F(amily) T(rust) for the S1/2 of Section 22.

As delineated in blue on the NDCRS site form map and aerial, the Thunder Spirit Wind Farm project proposed powerline corridor, access roads, and a turbine location abut the 32ADX204 parcel, but do not physically impact it as mapped.

We strongly encourage that the project applicant (and its contractors) be made aware that they restrict their activities to the corridor area surveyed and do not impact the 32ADX204 location.

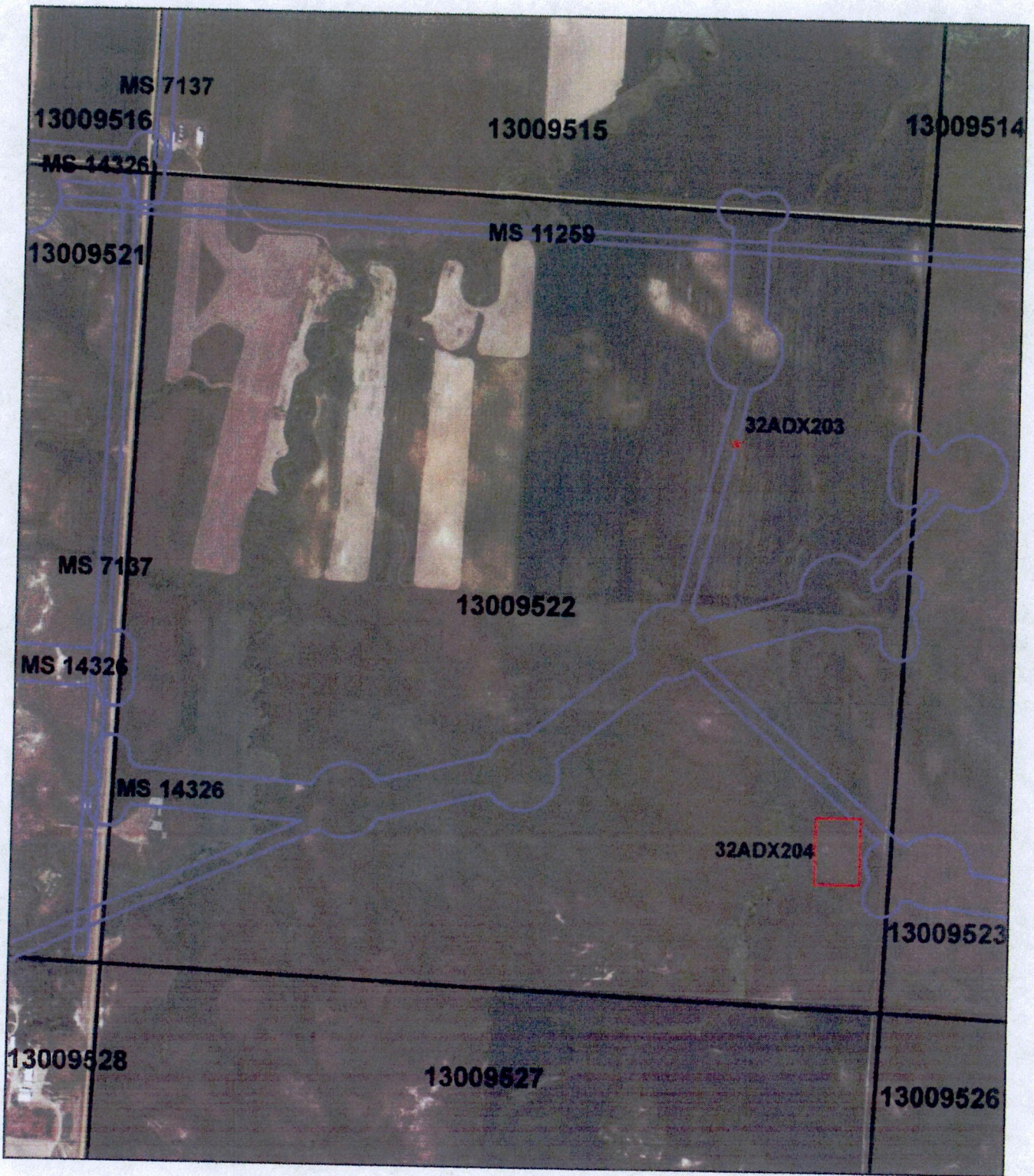

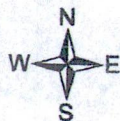
