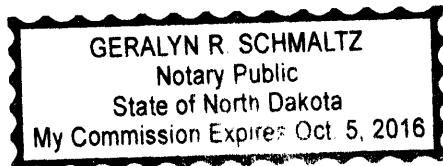

**NOTICE OF FILINGS AND NOTICE OF HEARING**

**November 30, 2011**

On October 21, 2011, Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC (“Enbridge”) filed applications for a certificate of corridor compatibility and for a route permit to authorize an upgrade of its existing Grenora Pump Station in Williams County, North Dakota. The upgrade is referred to as the Grenora Upgrade Project (“Project”). The Project includes the redesign and reconfiguration of the existing Grenora Pump Station which will include a new shipper-owned and operated truck-offloading facility to allow for increased injection capacity from its current capacity of 16,800 barrels per day (“bpd”) to a capacity of 59,670 bpd. Enbridge also plans to install a new 40,000 barrel tank for the receipt of new supply volumes. The Grenora Pump Station is a part of Enbridge’s 968 mile existing underground petroleum gathering and mainline pipeline system that extends from eastern Montana through North Dakota to Minnesota. All Project construction and work activities will be performed within the existing property boundaries of Enbridge’s Grenora Pump Station. *See* the application and attached maps for Project details and location.

Enbridge also filed a request for waivers of procedures and time schedules under North Dakota Century Code section 49-22-07.2 and North Dakota Administrative Code chapter 69-06-06.

The Commission finds the applications are complete.

A Public Hearing on the applications is scheduled to begin **February 23, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. CST in Courtroom 2 at the Williams County Court House, 205 East Broadway, Williston, North Dakota, 58801.**

The issues to be considered in Enbridge’s request for waiver of procedures and time schedules:

1. Are the proposed facilities of such length, design, location, or purpose that they will produce minimal adverse effects and that adherence to applicable procedures and time schedules may be waived?
2. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive any procedures and time schedules as requested in the application?


The issues to be considered in Enbridge's applications for certificate of corridor compatibility and route permit:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
