

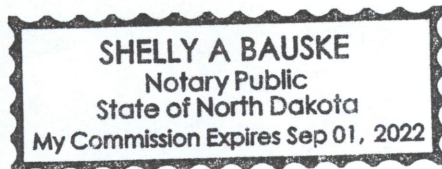

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

July 9, 2018

On August 29, 2012, the Commission adopted its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issuing Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 30 to ALLETE Clean Energy, Inc. (ACE) authorizing construction of a 100 MW Clean Energy #1 Wind Project in Mercer and Morton Counties of North Dakota.

On June 13, 2018, ACE filed a request to amend the Commission's August 29, 2012 Order to remove language that appears to require notice and opportunity for hearing prior to approving project modifications.

The issue to be determined is whether the Commission's August 29, 2012 Order should be amended.


Comments and requests for hearing must be received by August 20, 2018. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. If deemed appropriate, the commission can determine these matters without a hearing.
