**NOTICE OF FILING, NOTICE OF HEARING, AND
NOTICE OF INTERVENTION DEADLINE**

November 23, 2011

On May 12, 2011 and November 3, 2011, Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) filed for approval to implement a transmission cost recovery rider pursuant to North Dakota Century Code Section 49-05-04.3. Otter Tail proposes to recover Midwest Independent System Operator (MISO) Schedule 26 transmission related costs net of revenues allocated to North Dakota retail customers and the North Dakota retail share of revenue requirements for transmission facilities not currently included in base rates. The application includes an initial rate adjustment amount to be included as part of the Energy and Renewable Adjustment line on customers' bills:

<u>Customer Class</u>	<u>Amount per kWh</u>
Large General Service	\$0.00199
Controlled Service	\$0.00038
Lighting Service	\$0.00154
All Other Service	\$0.00272

The issues to be considered in these proceedings are whether the proposed transmission cost recovery rider and rate adjustments comply with section 49-05-04.3 and should be approved.

Anyone wishing to become a party to this proceeding must file a **Petition to Intervene by January 14, 2012**.

A **Formal Hearing** of this matter is scheduled to begin on **January 24, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. CST** in the Commission Hearing Room on the 12th floor of the State Capitol.
