

The Applicant shall mark all crossing sites with a post and sign on each side of the roadway. Signs shall be placed on County right-of-way line.

Please notify Township as to when work will start and finish. The contractor MUST have a copy of the permit and the cross section on site at all times.

4. A load of gravel shall be dumped onto, and spread across, all crossed prairie trails and township roads, and any ground disturbance on the township rite of way shall be put back to to its original apperance.
5. No pipeline work in this township shall begin until both and or all parties involved have signed the necessary paperwork and returned the signed papers to each other.
