Comments:

At this point in time estimated revenue is unknown. It is dependent on two factors;

1. If MDU serves grain bin site only or
2. If MDU serves grain bin site and residence.

The estimated cost of extension given is for three phase grain bin service only. If MDU serves residence along with grain bin site that cost could increase approximately \$1500.00. Dakota Valley stranded investment fee has not been figured in any MDU costs to the costumer.
