Transportation Security Administration spokeswoman Carrie Harmon told KFGO that the units are able to detect both metallic and nonmetallic objects under passengers' clothing using millimeter wave technology. This is not the same technology that's led to privacy concerns elsewhere.

Harmon said training for the machines is currently underway and they should be in place in Fargo in a few weeks. TSA officials think the use of the machine will speed up the screening process for passengers.

Harmon said it takes about three seconds to screen passengers using the new technology.

She said, "It's a very efficient and fast machine."

### N.D. electricity to offset Super Bowl


FARGO (AP) — Power generated in North Dakota is going to be used to offset some of the electricity used in Indianapolis on Super Bowl Sunday.

The Fargo Forum reported that renewable energy credits from power generated from wind farms near Langdon and north of Valley City will offset 15,000 megawatt hours of electricity associated with the game on Feb. 5.

Green Mountain Energy Co. in Austin, Texas, provided the credits, which were acquired from Minnkota Power Cooperative, based in Grand Forks.

The carbon offsets are associated with the electricity used at Lucas Oil Stadium, which is where the game is played; the Indiana Convention Center, site of the NFL Experience Football Theme Park; and four hotels hosting Super Bowl participating pants and media.

### Fargo man dies in apartment fire

FARGO (AP) — Fargo fire officials said a 31-year-old man died of apparent smoke inhalation in an early morning apartment fire.

Crews arrived at the apartment around 12:45 a.m. Sunday and found a fire in the kitchen of a first floor unit. Firefighters knocked down the blaze within minutes and transported James Peyton to Essentia Hospital, where he was pronounced dead.

Fire officials said it appears that only a limited number of smoke detectors were in place, which may have contributed to delayed fire discovery.

The fire appears to have started in the kitchen but a specific cause is pending further investigation.



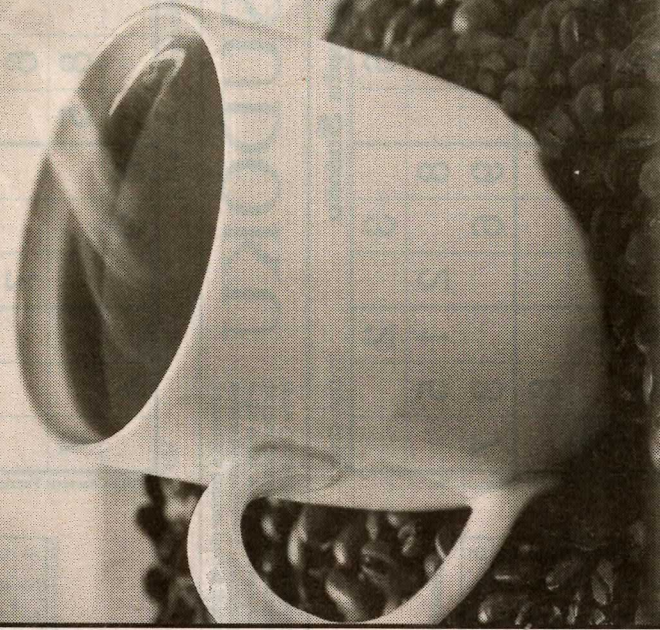
