

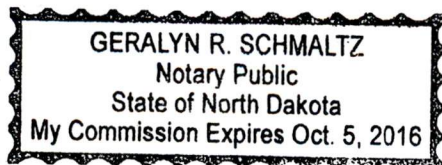

ORDER AND NOTICE

November 28, 2012

The evidence of record has been considered and appraised.

The Commission Orders:

1. The Hearing Officer's October 26, 2012 recommended Order Finding Respondent in Default, a copy of which is attached to this Order and made a part of this Order, is ADOPTED as the Public Service Commission's Order Finding Respondent in Default.
2. The facts before the Commission indicate that Shores did violate North Dakota Century Code Chapter 49-23 by failing to comply with the One Call procedures as outlined in North Dakota Century Code § 49-23-04, *et seq.*, as alleged in Advocacy Staff's August 23, 2012 formal complaint and supporting documentation.
3. This Order constitutes written notice of default and a statement of the grounds for default.
4. Shores Companies, Inc., 14620 Berg Rd NW Evansville, MN 56326, shall deposit the penal sum of \$2,000 with the Commission, unless a written Motion is filed, requesting that the default Order be vacated and stating the grounds relied upon, within seven days after service of the Order.


