NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On January 10, 2012 Otter Tail Power Company, an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend service to Curwood Seefeldt at a location in LaMoure County, North Dakota.

Submitted with the application was a statement by Curwood Seefeldt that the customer desires electric service to be provided by the applicant. Service is to be provided at a point located in:

**The NE ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 33, Twp. 135N, R 61W,
LaMoure County, North Dakota.**

Otter Tail Power Company has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **March 5, 2012**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
