NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On January 12, 2012, Northern States Power Company (NSP) filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a proposed 230 kV Peace Garden Switching Station and 300 feet of 230 kV electric transmission line to interconnect the proposed Border Winds Energy Project to the existing 230 kV Rugby-to-Glenboro transmission line in Rolette County, North Dakota.


The issues to be considered in this matter are:

1. Whether public convenience and necessity will be served by construction and operation of the facilities.
2. Whether the applicants are fit, willing and able to provide service.



Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceedings and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by **March 7, 2012**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
