Letter of Intent/Application for Waiver of Procedures and Time Frames
Fargo Relocation Project

Dear Mr. Nitschke:

Pursuant to Section 49-22-07.1 of the North Dakota Century Code and Section 69-06-03-01 of the North Dakota Administrative Code, Magellan Midstream Partners, L.P. ("Magellan"), hereby files its letter of intent to relocate approximately 2,300 feet of the existing co-located six (6) and eight (8)-inch petroleum product pipelines (the "Project"). The Project is necessary to accommodate the North Dakota Department of Transportation ("ND DOT") scheduled roadway reconstruction project. The Project will occur entirely within the Fargo, North Dakota city limits located in Cass County, North Dakota. Magellan is also requesting that the Commission waive certain procedures and time frames. As more specifically discussed herein, Magellan requests at this time that the Commission waive or modify the requirement that a letter of intent be filed one year before filing an application.

1. Description of size and type of facility and area to be served.

Magellan currently operates several miles of petroleum product transportation pipeline facilities throughout the State of North Dakota. The Project is proposed to consist of the relocation of approximately 2,300 feet of co-located 6 and 8-inch pipe, of which all will be located within the State of North Dakota. The Project will not modify existing designed capacity of approximately 65,000 barrels of petroleum products per day at an operating pressure between 950 and 1100 psig, rather this is modification of Magellan's existing system which is necessitated due to ND DOT road improvements and expansion. Construction is anticipated to commence in March of 2012 to accommodate the ND DOT roadway expansion project, with an estimated completion date of July 31, 2012. Magellan will construct and operate the relocated pipelines pursuant to U.S. Department of Transportation safety regulations.

2. Request for waiver of procedures and time frames.

To minimize delay, Magellan requests that the Commission waive the requirement of filing a letter of intent at least one year prior to filing the application for a certificate, or alternatively reduce such period to fifteen (15) days so as to allow the application to be filed in mid-January and this project to be timely permitted, constructed and placed in service ahead of the ND DOT roadway expansion project.

3. Map of study area.

See map enclosed herewith.

4. Anticipated construction and operation schedule.

Magellan anticipates commencing construction of the Pipeline in March of 2012, with an estimated completion date of July 31, 2012. This schedule is planned as such to meet the ND DOT roadway relocation schedule.

5. Estimated cost of construction.

Magellan estimates that total cost of constructing the Project will be approximately \$1,342,500.00.
