Mr. Nitschke:

On April 19, 2012, Magellan Midstream Partners, L.P. (Magellan) received a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility (#132) for the Fargo Relocation Project (Project) from the North Dakota Public Service Commission (Commission).

This memo is to advise the Commission that Magellan removed a total of three (3) trees (two deciduous and one conifer) during construction of the Project. Please refer to the attached map for exact locations. In accordance with the Commission's specifications, trees must be replaced on a 2:1 basis. Magellan is coordinating with the City of West Fargo to plant eight (8) trees in the project area in spring 2013. Documentation identifying the number, variety, type, location and date of the replacement plantings will be filed with the Commission upon completion of the work. Annual inspection of the replacement trees will commence in September 2014 and will continue for three (3) years.

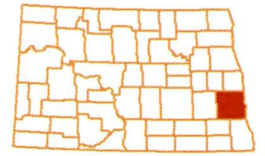
