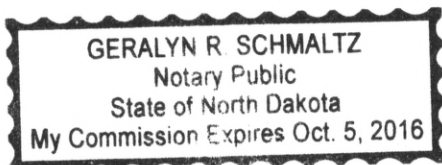

ORDER REISSUING CERTIFICATE AND PERMIT

April 11, 2012

The Public Service Commission's November 2, 2011 Order Granting Corridor Certificate and Route Permit in Case No. PU-11-99 issued Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 126 and Route Permit Number 135 to Arrow Field Services, LLC to construct and operate approximately 1.5 miles of 8-inch crude oil pipeline with associated facilities and pipeline interconnections in McKenzie County, North Dakota.

On January 26, 2012, Arrow Field Services, LLC and Banner Transportation Company, LLC submitted a joint application for the transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 126 and Route Permit Number 135 to Banner Transportation Company, LLC, a Oklahoma limited partnership with its principal office in Enid, Oklahoma and authorized to do business in the State of North Dakota, Case No. PU-12-47.

On February 15, 2012, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing, which provided until March 23, 2012 for receiving written comments or requests for hearing. No response was received. The notice stated the issues to be considered are whether Banner agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of Corridor Compatibility Number 126 and Route Permit Number 135 to Banner, and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

The January 25, 2012 affidavit of Jim Suttle, SVP Crude Oil Services, states that Banner agrees to assume the rights and obligations of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 126 and Route Permit Number 135, including the conditions and limitations set forth in the Commission's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order, dated November 2, 2011, issuing said Certificate and Route Permit, Case No. PU-11-99.

The requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.


The Commission Orders:

1. The application for transfer of Certificate of Corridor Compatibility Number 126 and Route Permit Number 135 is granted.




