On January 31 2012, Northern States Power Company (NSP) filed an application for advance determination of prudence for its proposed Purchase Power Agreement (PPA) for 200 megawatts of wind energy from Geronimo Wind Energy LLC generated at their Prairie Rose Wind Project located in Rock and Pipestone Counties, Minnesota.

A **public hearing** on this case will be held beginning **October 22, 2012 at 8:30 a.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, State Capitol, 12th Floor, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505. The issue to be considered in this case is whether the resource addition is prudent.
