ORDER GRANTING ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE


On September 24, 2012, Elizabeth M. Brama of the firm of Briggs and Morgan, P.A., filed a Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice, and Affidavit of Elizabeth M. Brama, with the North Dakota Public Service Commission. Ms. Brama seeks admission to practice pro hac vice in North Dakota, representing Northern States Power Company ("Xcel Energy") before the Commission in Northern States Power Company Application for Advance Determination of Prudence Geronimo Wind Application, PU-12-59. On March 20, 2012, Administrative Law Judge Patrick J. Ward was designated to preside as procedural hearing officer in Northern States Power Company Application for Advance Determination of Prudence Geronimo Wind Application, PU-12-59.
