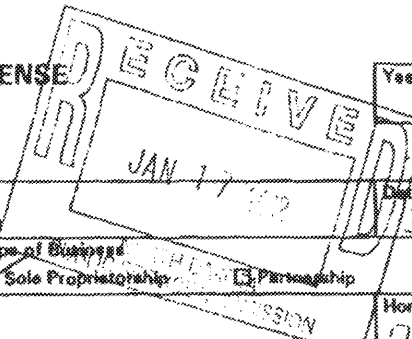

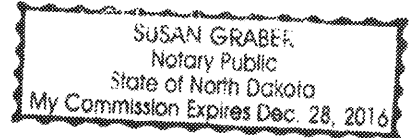
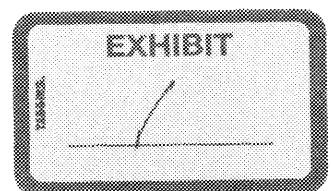

In 2003 I served as a District 2 Council Representative for the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Indians, While being in council and not knowing a whole lot in regards to the way that federal money could and couldn't be spent I ended up pleading guilty to misuse of funds in excess of \$1,000 . At this time in my life I was one of the youngest members to ever be elected into tribal council and this is one of the learning lessons that I encountered and deeply regretted. I took full responsibility for my actions and have learned a great deal while going through this ordeal.

In 2007, I was employed with the Turtle Mountain Fitness Center at this time I was having some work related issues that were brought forward to a meeting with the Tribal Council. During this time I was given time off with pay until the issues were resolved. I was at home one day and the person I was having issues with started to assault me at my home. I defended myself in my yard at home. I was taken to court and went through a jury trial that ended in me being guilty of assault. I believed in protecting myself at home but apparently the jury didn't believe so. I am not proud of having this on my record but I live my life every day to be trustworthy and to work hard so that I can give back to my community.

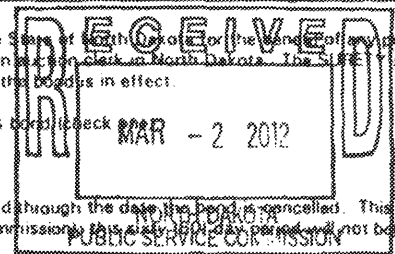

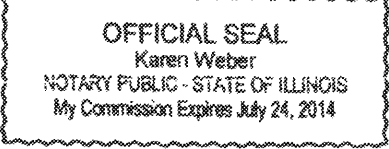
