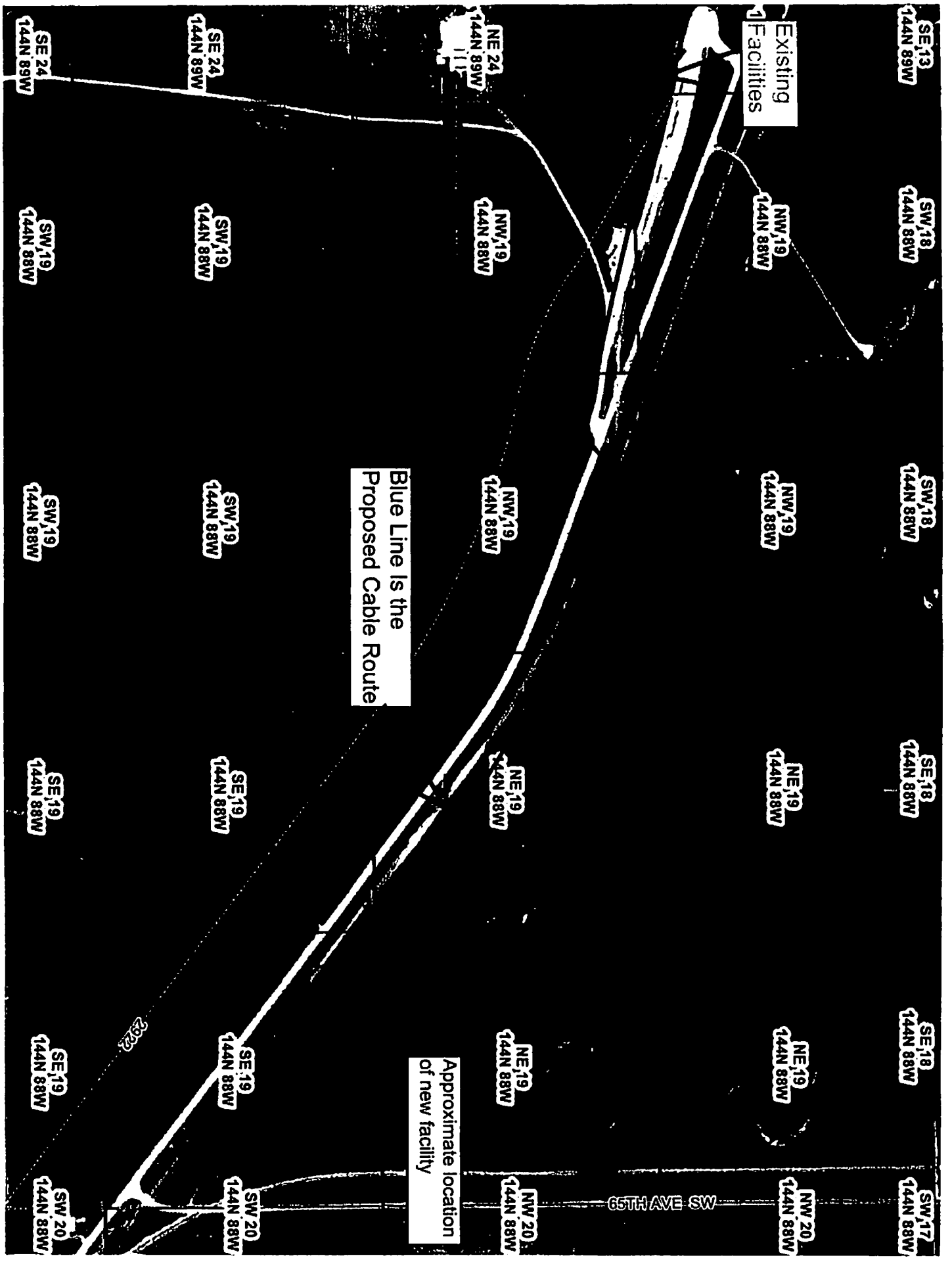

Comments:
 MDU serves Basin Transload's first facility and to serve the new facility there will be a three phase extension to Basin Transload's 2nd facility. This new facility is approximately one mile east of their existing facility located at 6550 East County Road. The underground circuit will cross under BNSF railroad spur. The 7,900' distance to the REC is only an estimate as exact location of REC line is uncertain.
