Public Input Meeting to be held June 21 to discuss a proposed Watford City Updated Land Use Plan and a future Watford City Transportation Plan

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. CST on Thursday, June 21 at the Outlaws Bar & Grill, 120 N. Main Street, Watford City. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 6:00 p.m.

The purposes of the Public Input Meeting are to discuss the proposed City-wide Updated Land Use Plan and identify issues of the existing transportation system to assist in developing a City-wide Transportation Plan.

The purpose of the Updated Land Use Plan is to propose future Watford City limits and designate land use types (e.g. residential, commercial, industrial, etc.) within these Watford City limits. Graphics will be provided depicting the proposed Updated Land Use Plan for review and public input.

Additionally, the current, short, and long range transportation system needs of the community will be a topic of discussion. The future Transportation Plan will focus on improvements that address pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular issues, including safety, traffic congestion, and connectivity to locations in and around Watford City.

The Public Input Meeting will provide an opportunity for the Public to ask questions and provide input on the proposed Updated Land Use Plan and the future Transportation Plan. These two subjects will be important tools aiding the City of Watford City's organized growth. Representatives from the City of Watford City, Advanced Engineering and Environmental Services, Inc. (AE2S) and Kadrmass, Lee & Jackson, Inc. (KL&J) will be available to answer questions.
