Mail reviewed. Council reviewed the status of the "Welcome to Port- land" signs that should be installed this week. Water quality report for 2011 was accepted by the North Da- kota Department of Health. North Dakota Workforce Safety & Insurance will be conducting a premium audit on Wednesday June 13, 2012. Xcel en- ergy will be performing necessary up- grades to the electrical system and will involve a power outage on Wednes- day June 13, 2012 between the hours of 3am and 5am.
