The scope of work generally consists of furnishing and installing the following:  
General Building Construction (LUMP SUM): Work generally includes mobilization, bonding, insurance; furnish and install a new canopy bearing wall building with sloped steel roof, structural supported on reinforced concrete allow foundation system; finishes (painting, coatings); electrical site work and controls; miscellaneous backfilling; and miscellaneous related construction, equipment and purtenances.
