The Powers Lake City Council met with the public for input on the Frac Sand Elevator on Wednesday, June 6. Council members present were: Enget, Griesbach, Carlson, and Sellie. Also present were Connie Rosencrans, Diane Isakson, Farrell Larson, Ryan Larson, Betty Ledene, Terry Slotsve, Arlene Jensen, Ardy Enget, Carl Zeltinger, Doug Eckert, Roy Jensen, Kenny Essen, Sandy Jensen, Tyler Grubb, Mike Gunderson, Bonnie Jorgenson, Betty VanBerkom, Kari Enget and Marilyn Albertson, acting secretary. Meeting called to order by Mayor Albertson at 7 p.m.

Carl Zeltinger, PL Elevator general manager gave an overview of the proposed frac sand facility. 20 train car loads at a time with a max of 40 per week. The track to Powers Lake is very weak and needs repair. The facility may create more jobs, but could cause more dust in the air. This facility could save our elevator, if the rail track is closed more truck traffic would be needed to haul all the grain away. The sand in the facility is all cleaned before it gets to Powers Lake. Concerns were raised over increase truck traffic and children safety. The track from Powers Lake to Stanley in certain spots needs repair, business plan would be proposed in Jan. 2013. Saving the elevator is the #1 plus in this frac sand facility. Public input mtg adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
