Dorothy Lantto's daughter Margie and her kids Paul and Roxy and Dorothy's son Jim visited her on Sunday.

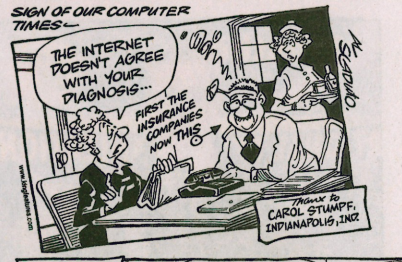
Fancy and Rooster Reynolds spent Thursday to Monday near Round Up, MT with their dad Wes as he worked on an oil rig job. Sounds like fun.

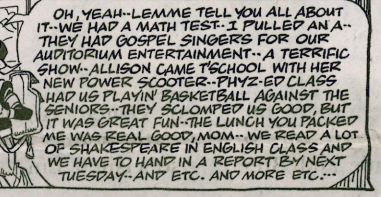
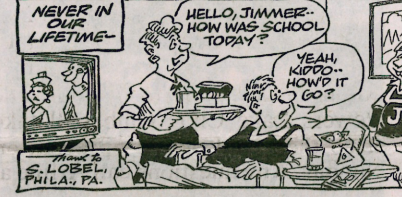
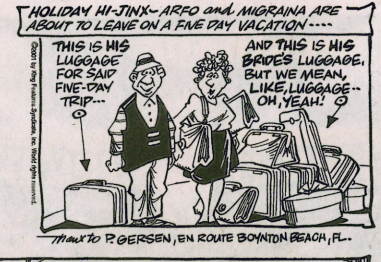
