IT WAS MOVED by Feltman, seconded by Carignan, and carried unanimously by roll call vote that the school board election hours be changed to the same polling hours (9 a.m. to 7 p.m.) as the general election and that the polling site be changed from the Central Middle School to the Walsh County Courthouse.

IT WAS MOVED by Carignan, seconded by Presteng, and carried unanimously by roll call vote that the second reading of amended policies JAA - Use of Architect and KACB - Patron Complaints about Personnel be acknowledged as complete; that the policies be adopted with the wording and changes as listed in the minutes of the April 10, 2012 board meeting.

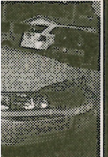
