

Headworks - Control House placement will be received at an office of **Garrison Diversion Conservancy District, 401 Hwy 1 NE, Carrington, ND 58421**, til 2:00 p.m., local time, on the **th day of June, 2012**, where and which time they will be publicly ened and read aloud.

The scope of work generally consists of furnishing and installing as following:

General Building Construction (LUMP SUM): Work generally includes mobilization, bonding, insurance; furnish and install a new masonry bearing wall building with sloped steel roof, structural supported on reinforced concrete allow foundation system; finishes painting, coatings); electrical site work and controls; miscellaneous related construction, equipment and appurtenances.

The control system will operate 10x10 gates which will control water entering the McClusky Canal. The controls will have capabilities to operate gates manually or automatically. In automatic mode each gate will open and close to obtain the proper flow through the canal. The control system will have the ability to monitor and control gates and will be via internet and provide critical alarm signals to the operator.

All Bids shall be prepared according to the Instruction to Bidders contained within the Project Manual. Each Bid shall be accompanied by **separate envelope** containing a Bid Security in the form of a Bidder's bond executed by the Bidder as a principal and by a surety company authorized to do business in the State of North Dakota, payable to the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District, in a sum equal to five percent (5%) of the full amount of the bid. This is to serve as a guarantee that the successful Bidder will enter into a Contract with fifteen (15) days Notice of Award, in accordance with the terms of the principal's Bid and Contractor's Bond as required by law and regulations and terms of the Garrison Diversion

Each bid shall contain a copy of the Contractor's license or certificate of renewal thereof issued by the Secretary of State. All Bids must be submitted on the Bid Form furnished by the Engineer. No Bid will be read or considered that does not fully comply with the above provisions and other provisions contained within the Bidding Documents, and any deficient Bid submitted will be returned to the Bidder unopened.

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Bidders on this Work will be required to comply with Title 40 CFR 35.3145(d). The requirements for Bidders and Contractors under this regulation concerning utilization of Minority Business Enterprises (MBE), Women's Business Enterprises (WBE), and Small Business Enterprises (SBE) are explained in the Specifications. The goal for MBE is 1% of the total dollar value of the Project. The goal for WBE is 2% of the total dollar value of the Project.

Bidders on this Work will be required to comply with the Presidential Executive Order No. 11246, as amended. The requirements for Bidders and Contractors under this order are explained in the Specifications.

Contracts shall be awarded on the basis of the low Bid submitted by a responsible and responsive Bidder deemed most favorable to Garrison Diversion's interest.

All Bids shall be contained in a sealed envelope plainly marked showing that such envelope contains a Bid for the Project. In addition, the Bidder shall place upon the exterior of such envelope the following information:

1. Project Name and Work covered by the Bidder (General).
2. The name of the Bidder.
3. Federal ID Number
4. Separate envelope containing Bid Bond, a copy of Contractor's License or Renewal Certificate of Debarment, and MBE/WBE Sub-contractor Solicitation Information.
5. Acknowledgement of all Addenda.

The Owner reserves the right to hold the three (3) Bids for a period of thirty (30) days after the date of the Bid opening to complete financial arrangements.

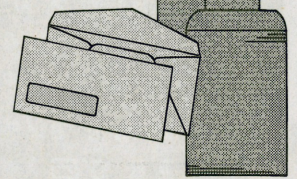
