**RE: North Dakota Telephone Company - Revisions to Access Services Tariff
To be filed April 30, 2012-North Dakota Public Service Commission**

Dear Ms. Kuhn:

This letter is intended to resolve for North Dakota Telephone Company, (North Dakota Telephone) all outstanding issues that Verizon has raised with respect to the filing made by BEK Communications, Cooperative, (BEK) that was filed with the North Dakota Public Service Commission (NDPSC) on March 5, 2012, by John Staurulakis, Inc. on behalf of BEK. In light of the fact that the VoIP/PSTN tariff revisions filed by North Dakota Telephone on April 30, 2012, are identical to the VoIP/PSTN tariff revisions filed by BEK in early March, this letter is appropriate and intended to resolve the same issues.

In regards to Verizon's first issue regarding the language contained in Section 2.1.1.G of the proposed BEK tariff revisions, which corresponds with Section 8.1.1.G of the proposed North Dakota Telephone tariff revision, North Dakota Telephone indicates that at the appropriate time in the future, it will file tariff revisions with the NDPSC outlining how their PVU factor will be determined, once it becomes necessary for North Dakota Telephone to compute a PVU factor due to the introduction of VoIP/PSTN traffic on North Dakota Telephone's network. This future filing will remove all uncertainty regarding how North Dakota Telephone's PVU factor will be determined.

In regards to Verizon's second issue regarding the effective date of the implementation of interstate access rates as the basis for pricing traffic designated as VoIP/PSTN traffic by Verizon, North Dakota Telephone agrees to begin assessing interstate access rates for such designated VoIP/PSTN traffic as of January 1, 2012.


