RE: dishNET Wireline L.L.C. Tariff Advice Letter No. 4

Dear Mr. Nitchke:

Enclosed for filing with the Public Service Commission of North Dakota are amended Sheet Nos. 2, 6, 7, 33 to 35, and 38 to dishNET Wireline L.L.C.'s ("dishNET") switched exchange access telecommunications tariff, North Dakota P.S.C. Tariff No. 2.

With this submission, dishNET reduces its terminating switched exchange access rates by 50 percent of the differential between the Company's current intrastate composite switched access rate and corresponding interstate composite rate as set forth in dishNET's F.C.C. Tariff No. 1,<sup>1</sup> pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") November 18, 2012 *Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*, in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, *et al.*, FCC 11-161. The Company also introduces separate originating switched exchange access rate that mirrors its existing switched exchange access rate, adds a Shared Port access component description, and adds definitions for clarity.

Confidential supporting information pursuant to the Commission's May 3, 2012 Letter to All North Dakota Local Exchange Companies RE: The Federal Communications Commission Report and Order FCC 11-161, Commission's Request for Carriers to Submit Revised Tariff to the Commission for Implementation on July 1, 2012 is enclosed under seal with the paper submission. dishNET requests the tariff become effective on July 3, 2012 pursuant to the FCC's June 5, 2012 Clarification Order, DA 12-870.

dishNET requests trade secret protection of its Fiscal Year 2011 Intrastate demand (volume) for intrastate access services. Pursuant to North Dakota Administrative Code §69-02-09-01, dishNET provides the following support for its request:

1. A general description of the nature of the information sought to be protected;

dishNET requests trade secret protection of its Fiscal Year 2011 Intrastate demand (volume) for intrastate access services.

2. An explanation of why the information derives independent economic value, actual or potential, from not being generally known to other persons;

The Company's intrastate access services demand (volume) provides competitors with detailed information regarding the Company's scope of operations in North Dakota, and allows interpolation of the Company's scope of operations in other states.

3. An explanation of why the information is not readily ascertainable by proper means by other persons;

dishNET would not otherwise have occasion to make such demand data available to the public.

4. A general description of the persons or entities that would obtain economic value from disclosure or use of the information;

Any local exchange carrier operating in North Dakota or surrounding states would derive economic value from the knowledge of the Company's scope of operations.

5. A specific description of known competitors and competitors' goods and services that are pertinent to the tariff or rate filing; and

All dominant incumbent and competitive local exchange carriers operating in North Dakota and surrounding states

6. A description of the efforts used to maintain the secrecy of the information.


