On November 26, 2012, Hess Corporation (Hess), submitted a Certificate of Corridor Compatibility and a Route Permit for its RTF Tie-In 14" Crude Oil Pipeline Project to the Public Service Commission (Case No. PU-12-683).

Per Condition #4 of the Certification Relating to Order Provisions - Transmission Facility Siting, Hess is required to provide copies of all environmental permits. Please find the Notice of Coverage for the Ramberg Crude Stabilization Facility and the Tioga Rail Terminal.
