**BUDGET PREPAY, INC.
CERTIFICATION**


I, David Donahue, CFO of Budget PrePay, Inc. d/b/a Budget Mobile ("Budget PrePay"), hereby certify on behalf of Budget PrePay the following:

1. I have carefully examined all the statements and matters contained in Budget PrePay's August 31, 2012 application ("Application") for designation as a competitive eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") in certain non-rural and rural wire centers in North Dakota. All statements made and matters set forth in the Application are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief.
2. Budget PrePay will utilize the federal low-income universal service support it receives only for the provision of services for which the support is intended.
3. As set forth in the Application, Budget PrePay meets all of the prerequisites to be designated as an ETC throughout its proposed ETC Designated Area in the state of North Dakota.
4. As detailed in the Application, Budget PrePay provides each of the services supported by federal universal service support mechanisms, as set forth in Sections 54.101 *et seq.* of the FCC's rules, and will offer these supported services in North Dakota upon designation as an ETC, including voice grade access, minutes of use for local service at no additional charge, access to emergency services and toll limitation services.
5. As set forth in NDAC § 69-09-05-12(3)(a)(1), upon designation as an ETC, Budget PrePay is committed to providing the supported services on a timely basis to requesting customers within Budget PrePay's proposed designated service area, where Budget PrePay's underlying carriers' network already passes the potential customer's premises.
6. As set forth in Budget PrePay's ETC Application, Budget PrePay will satisfy the intent of NDAC § 69-09-05-12(3)(a)(2) by complying with all service requirements applicable to Lifeline support funding, as detailed in the Application and in the Company's Compliance Plan set forth at Exhibit C to the Application.
7. Budget PrePay is not seeking USF high-cost support as part of its Application.
8. Budget PrePay has taken, and will continue to take, steps to work with its underlying carriers to remain functional in emergency situations by: (1) maintaining a reasonable amount of backup power to ensure functionality without local alternating (AC) commercial power; (2) establishing to the extent feasible the ability to re-route traffic around damaged facilities and to manage traffic spikes resulting from emergency situations; and (3) establishing procedures for employees to follow in an emergency to prevent or minimize interruption or impairment of telecommunications services.

9. Budget PrePay will satisfy the applicable consumer protection and quality standards. As set forth in Budget PrePay's Compliance Plan (Exhibit C to the Application), Budget PrePay will abide by CTIA's Consumer Code for Wireless Service ("CTIA Code").
10. Budget PrePay will advertise the availability of the supported services detailed in its Application, and the corresponding rates and charges, in a manner designed to inform the general public within North Dakota. This advertising will occur through a combination of media channels, such as television and radio, newspaper, magazine and other print advertisements, outdoor advertising, direct marketing, and the Internet.
11. Budget PrePay offers calling plans that provide customers local usage that is comparable to the incumbent local exchange company ("ILEC") when all of the additional features and functionalities and the inherent mobile nature of wireless service is taken into account.
12. Budget PrePay acknowledges that it may be required by the FCC to provide equal access to long distance carriers in the event that no other ETC provides equal access within Budget PrePay's designated ETC service area.
13. Budget PrePay will comply with all applicable annual reporting requirements associated with being an ETC in North Dakota.
14. As CFO of Budget PrePay, I have the authority to provide this Certification and to bind the Company as set forth herein.
