This letter is a follow up to our November 26, 2013 phone conversation explaining and correcting the information provided to you in my November 15, 2013 letter.

A measured inventory report is a report containing an estimate of the grain inventory that is measured during an examination. Consistent with standard practice the Commission inspectors conducted no weigh-up. A weigh-up must be completed to determine the exact amount of inventory.

The measured inventory reports identified the pinto beans as being a no. 1 grade because the examination program defaults to no. 1 grade. Consistent with standard practice, the inspectors took no samples to be graded. Without taking samples and submitting them for an official grade, the Commission would not know the grade.
