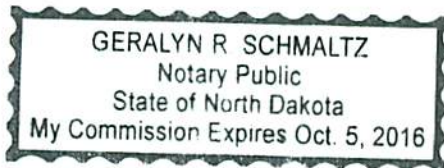

**NOTICE OF HEARING
June 19, 2013**

On May 10, 2013, Public Service Commission Advocacy Staff filed a formal complaint alleging violation of the North Dakota One-Call law, N.D.C.C. Chapter 49-23, and requesting the Commission find S. J. Louis Construction, Inc. responsible for violating the One Call law and impose a penalty of \$1,000.

On June 19, 2013, the Public Service Commission found the Complaint states a prima facie case and directed that the complaint be served on the Respondent, S. J. Louis Construction, Inc.

A public hearing on this matter will be held commencing on **September 9, 2013 at 1:30 p.m. CDT** in the Commission Hearing Room, State Capitol, 12th Floor, Bismarck, North Dakota 58505. The issues to be considered are:

1. Has S. J. Louis Construction, Inc. violated N.D.C.C. Chapter 49-23, the North Dakota One-Call law?
2. If a violation is found, should the Commission impose a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000.00?
