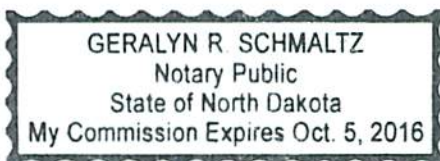

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

January 30, 2013

On December 20, 2012 Total Call Mobile, Inc. (Total Call) filed an application for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) for the purpose of receiving federal universal service support for low-income consumers under 47 CFR Part 54 Subpart E. Such designation is also known as Lifeline-only ETC designation. Total Call proposes to provide prepaid Lifeline universal services to qualifying low income customers as a commercial mobile radio service (CMRS) carrier in every wire center in North Dakota.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:


1. Is the applicant qualified under the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Section 214(e) for designation as an ETC eligible to receive federal universal service funding?
2. What ETC universal service support area should be designated?
3. Is designation of the applicant as an ETC in the public interest?

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. **Comments and requests for hearing must be received by close of business on March 19, 2013.** If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a formal hearing.
