After Basin Electric's Combined Corridor and Route Application was filed with the ND PSC in late February 2013, it was determined that Basin Electric's wholly owned subsidiary, Dakota Gasification Company (DGC), would ultimately own and operate the pipeline. The primary reasons for this change in ownership are DGC's superior experience in the operation and maintenance of compressed-gas pipelines and potential tax benefits available to DGC due to its for-profit status. As such, we wish to amend the application to indicate DGC as the owner/operator of the proposed facility. A Certificate of Good Standing from the ND Secretary of State for DGC is enclosed. Basin Electric staff and contractors would still design, permit and construct the facility.

In addition to the change in pipeline ownership, a number of refinements to the corridor and route are proposed to facilitate the construction of the facility. No new landowners are affected by these changes. The proposed refinements are minor, with the corridor/route shifting 100-300 feet east or west to better avoid existing utilities and to accommodate Coteau Properties' future development. These minor changes have negligible impact on the environmental analysis for the project and no new exclusion or avoidance areas are present in the updated corridor; however, additional Class III (pedestrian survey) cultural resources work will need to be completed to accommodate the reroutes. The results of the additional surveys are expected in May 2013, and will be provided to the ND SHPO for review and filed with the ND PSC. Figures 2 - 4 included in the original application have been revised to reflect the updated corridor/route and are enclosed with this letter.

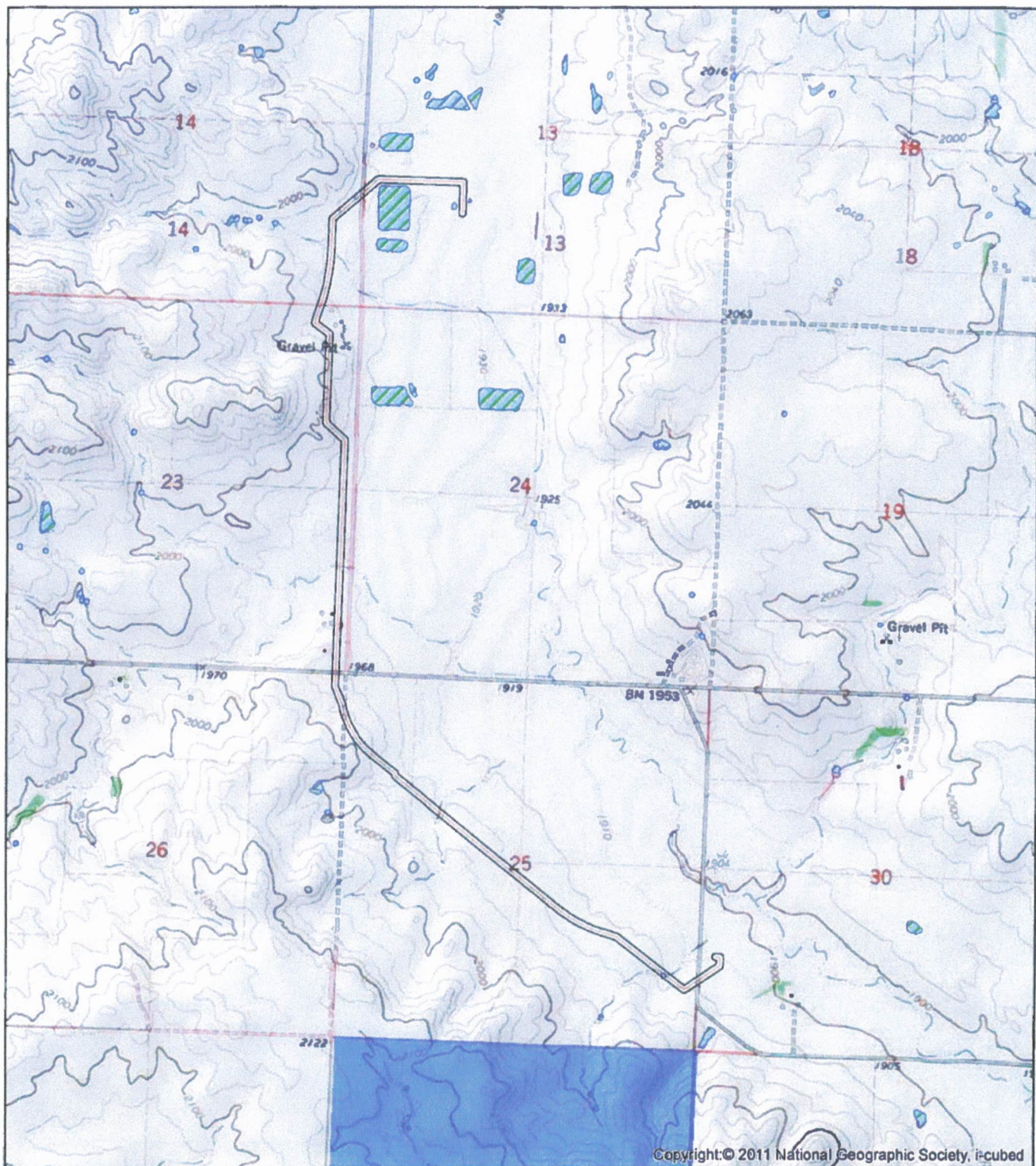

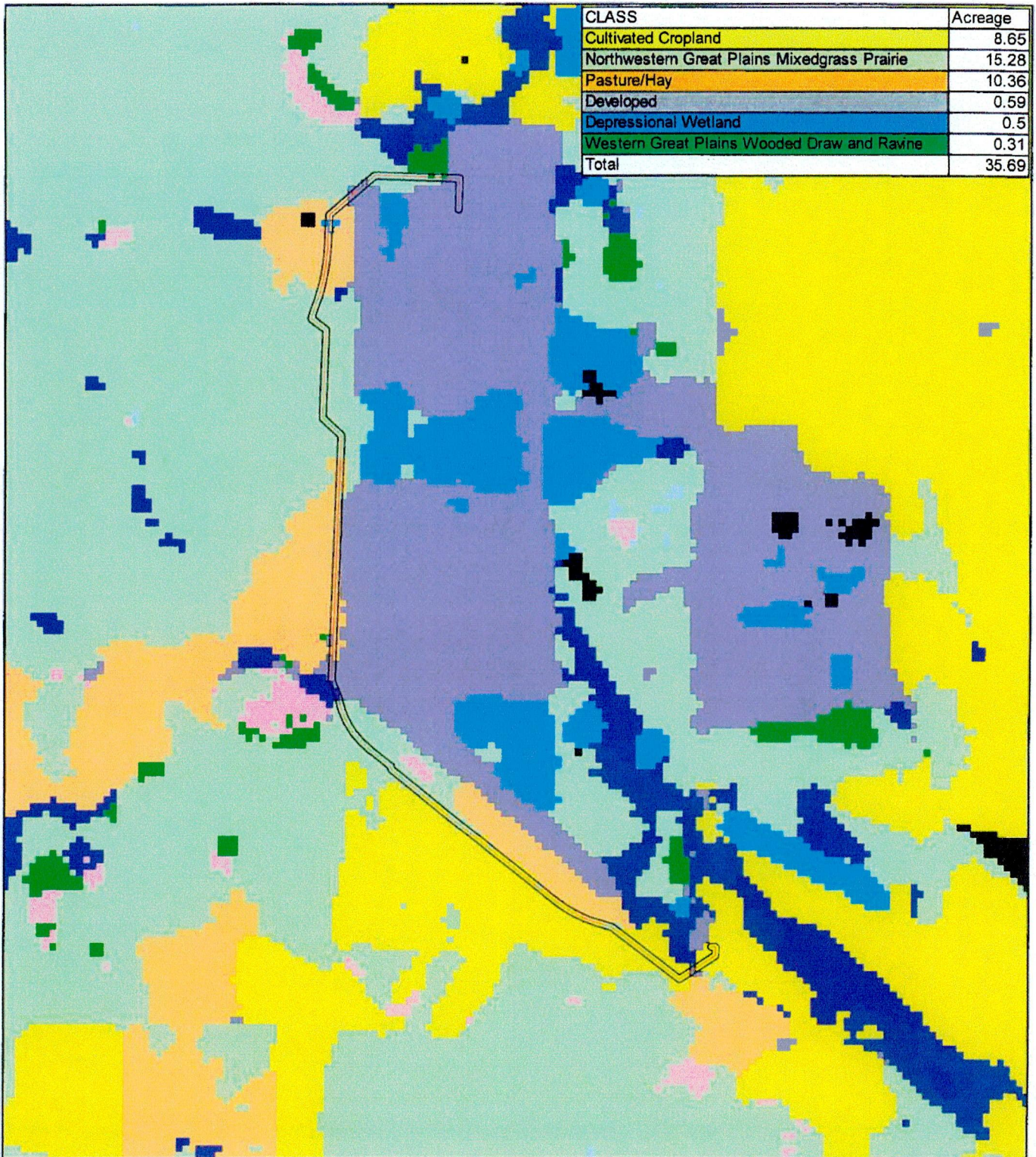
