Referenced is North Dakota PSC Case No. PU-13-22 (Dakota Gasification Company – Antelope Valley Station Natural Gas Pipeline).

Dakota Gasification Company (DGC) constructed a natural gas pipeline (Project) in Mercer County in accordance with the order issued by the PSC for the above-referenced case. The tree and shrub replacement plan for the Project was approved by the PSC in August 2014.

Approximately 26 trees and 28 shrubs were removed during construction of the Project, all of which were on land owned by DGC's parent company, Basin Electric Power Cooperative (Basin Electric). The Tree and Shrub Mitigation Specifications for Case No. PU-13-22 require that both trees and shrubs be replaced on a two for one basis; as such, approximately 52 trees and 56 shrubs (a total of 108) were needed as replacements.

A total of 140 trees and shrubs were planted at Basin Electric's Antelope Valley Station, amounting to approximately 130% of the minimum number required. A tree and shrub inspection was conducted by Basin Electric personnel on September 28, 2016. Ten trees were found to be missing, dead or in poor condition. All shrubs appeared to be doing well. In total, 130 trees and shrubs survived two years. Since only 108 trees and shrubs were required for mitigation, the current survival rate is in excess of 100%.
