Effective December 1, 2019, Telrite Corporation d/b/a Life Wireless ("Company") has increased the amount of data it provides in its wireless Lifeline plan in the State of North Dakota as follows:

Qualified new subscribers and existing subscribers will now receive 1,000 voice minutes, Unlimited Texts, 3 GB of data (up from 2 GB) and unlimited MMS (Multimedia Messaging Service – MMS – enables the sending of messages with multimedia content). These plans comply with the Federal Communications Commission's current minimum service standards.<sup>1</sup>

Subscribers can purchase additional airtime via their device, through the Company's customer service and at MoneyGram locations.
