Request To:

Operate two truck scales that deviate from North Dakota Weights and Measures rules as follows:

- 1) Less clearance (5 1/8") than required (12") between the "I" beam and the slab.
- 2) Less inside clearance (2' 6") than required (5') between the scale deck and the doorsill.
- 3) Approaches:
 - a. Less level concrete (10') than required (12') for the portion of the approach adjacent to the scale;
 - b. Greater slope (1.55" per foot) than allowed (1/3" per foot) for the remainder of the approach.

Permanent Variance Permit Conditions:

- Each scale must be retested and adjusted once every twelve months by a registered service company to maintain the required tolerance.
- The service company test reports must include both the "as found" and "as left" readings in addition to any maintenance notes.
- The twelve-month test reports must be submitted to the Commission within seven working days of the test date and a copy retained by Technisand, Inc.
- Except for the specific variance granted by Permit Numbers 479 and 480, each scale must be operated according to all applicable North Dakota Laws and Rules.
- The enclosed variance permit must be posted near the designated scale in a place clearly visible to the public.
- Failure to comply with the variance permit conditions may result in revocation.
