**NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF HEARING**

**May 22, 2013**

On April 12, 2013, Courtenay Wind Farm, LLC filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility to authorize construction of a wind energy project consisting of up to 200.5 MW total generating capacity consisting of wind turbines ranging up to 3 MW in size and associated facilities to be located in Stutsman County, North Dakota as shown on the attached map.

A **Public Hearing** on the application is scheduled to begin on **July 12, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. CDT at the Stutsman County Court House Law Enforcement Center, 205 6<sup>th</sup> St. SE, Jamestown, ND 58401.** The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

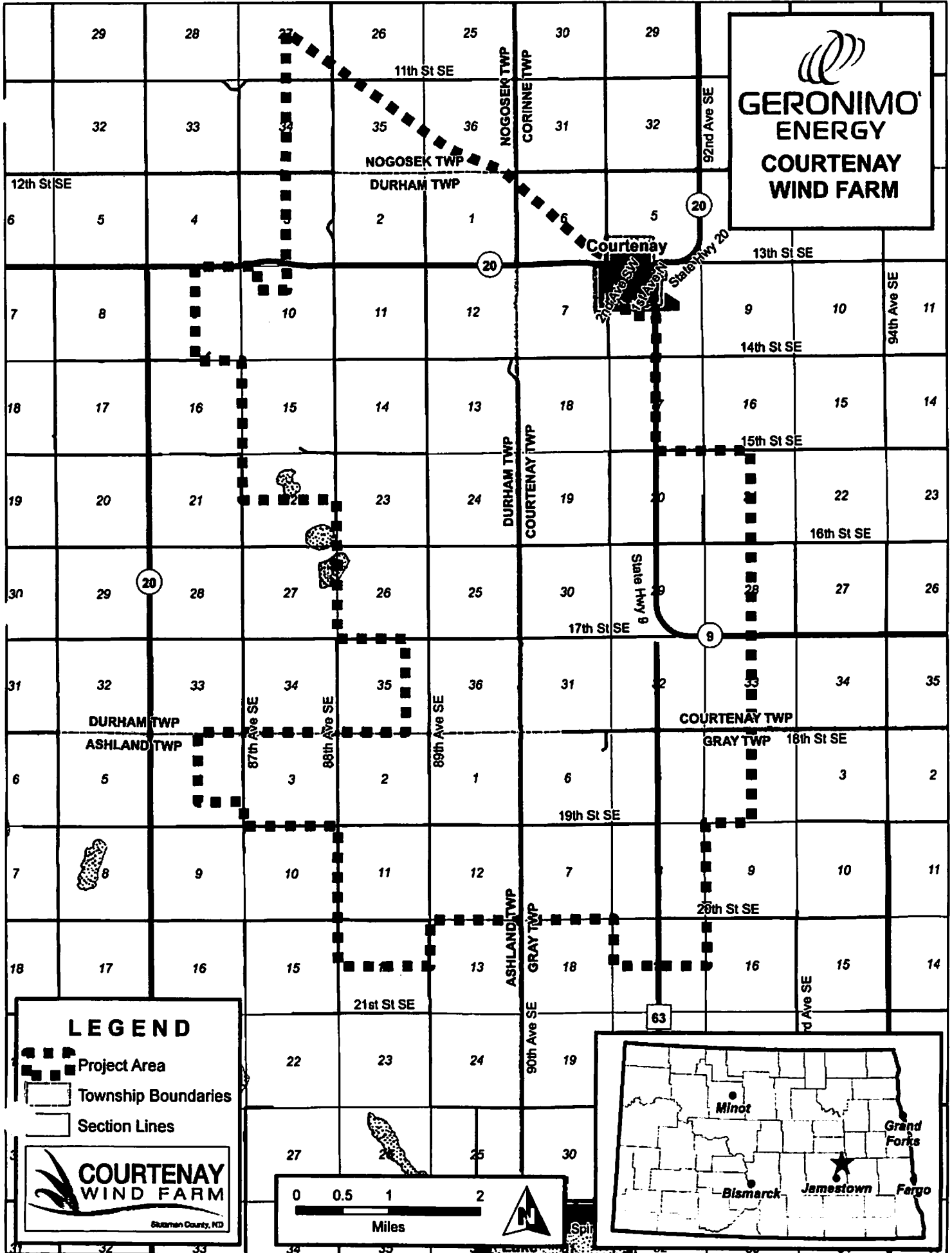
