NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On March 12, 2013, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend service to Kodiak Oil & Gas Corp. at a location in Williams County, North Dakota.

Submitted with the application was a statement by Kodiak Oil & Gas Corp. that the customer desires electric service to be provided by the applicant. Service is to be provided at a point located in:

Section 5, Twp. 159N, R 97W, Williams County, North Dakota.

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **April 29, 2013**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
