Bison 4 Storm Damage 7-21-14

On the evening of July 21th a storm came through the Bison 4 Project site causing damage to turbine components in Area 1 (401-407), Area 2 (408-414) and Area 4 (426-432). The main damage was to wind turbine blades at 6 new sites and 4 previously damaged sites. The overall damage is still being assessed and insurance adjusters will be onsite starting July 25 to help MP and associated contractors get through the claims process. Siemens is in the process of developing new procedures for tying down the larger blades that are being used on this project.

Wind speeds were slightly below what was experienced on 7/6/14
