

## Keith Kessler Complaint – Weekly Report

Case No. PU-13-127 & I-15-0195

September 4, 2018

- In response to Mr. Kessler's 8/23/18 request, Minnesota Power scheduled two contractors to complete the fence work, remove all splices and repair the erosion issue south of Turbine T441.
- During phone correspondence with Mr. Kessler 8/29/18, Mr. Kessler indicated that he wishes to be compensated for Minnesota Power/contractors to access the areas in order to make the repairs described above.
- Minnesota Power believes that the items above, which originated during performance of work under the original construction easement, should be repaired as part of the construction easement's obligations and that no additional/new compensation is required.
- During 9/4/18 correspondence with Mr. Kessler, he reiterated that no work will be allowed this week on his property without a new access agreement and subsequent compensation between Minnesota Power and Mr. Kessler.
  - The contractors, which were ready to perform the work described above, have been directed to postpone the work.
